

Getting the Bus to Riseholme College

Many of our students travel from home to college on a daily basis using our bus service. Riseholme College currently operates five bus routes across the region, as shown on the map above.

If you live on one of our existing bus routes, transport to and from college may be FREE. Please contact Student Services by calling **01522 304600** or emailing **enquiries@riseholme.ac.uk** to find out if you are eligible.

Bus Passes

If you are entitled to free college transport, a bus pass will be issued during enrolment. Once the bus pass is issued it must be shown to the bus driver on each journey. Failure to show your bus pass forfeits your privilege of free travel.

If the bus pass is lost / damaged a replacement can be purchased from Student Services for £5 (£10 if a new lanyard is required). Pop in or give them a call on 01522 304600 for more information.

Behaviour on College Buses

Students will be expected to behave appropriately at all times. This includes the time spent at the bus terminal as well as during the bus journey.

Anyone found to demonstrate a lack of respect towards others be they fellow students, staff or members of the public will be disciplined and may forfeit their right to travel on the college buses.

Free Bus Routes

The below details the inward times for our bus services. All timings are approximate and you are advised to be at your pick-up point at least 10 minutes before the time stated. If you miss the bus, you must make your own travel arrangements to the college.

Please raise your arm for the bus to stop. The bus will not stop automatically at every stop on the route

All buses depart from Riseholme College's Showground campus for return journeys at 17:15.

Parking at Riseholme College

Students can park free of charge at any time at the college. However, you will need to apply for a parking permit. You can apply in advance by completing the application on our website. You'll find it at www.riseholme.ac.uk/parking

The college aims to provide students with car parking facilities that are safe, secure and convenient. For the safety of everyone on site, all persons must obey traffic signs, speed limits and follow any instructions from staff.

The college operates a barrier system. Barriers can be opened using your student ID card. However, all vehicles must be registered beforehand. Accommodation

If you don't think travelling in every day will work for you, don't worry! We have accommodation on site for both further education and higher education students.
