Getting the bus to Riseholme College

Many of our students travel from home to college on a daily basis using our bus service. Riseholme College currently operates five bus routes across the region, as shown on the map above.

- If you live on one of our existing bus routes, transport to and from college may be FREE.
- If you can use public transport to meet our existing bus routes, we will reimburse the costs e.g. public bus services or train services

PLEASE NOTE: You MUST stick your arm out to stop the bus.

Bus Passes

All students must submit an application for transport funding via the PayMyStudent Portal as part of their enrolment. If you are entitled to free college transport, a bus pass will be issued during enrolment. Once the bus pass is issued it must be shown to the bus driver on each journey. Failure to show your bus pass forfeits your privilege of free travel.

Behaviour on college buses

Students will be expected to behave appropriately at all times. This includes the time spent at the bus terminal as well as during the bus journey.

Anyone found to demonstrate a lack of respect towards fellow students, staff or members of the public, may be subject to disciplinary procedures that could forfeit the right to travel on college buses.

Bus Routes

The below details the inward times for our bus services. All timings are approximate and you are advised to be at your pick-up point at least 10 minutes before the time stated. If you miss the bus, you must make your own travel arrangements to the college.

Please raise your arm for the bus to stop. The bus will not stop automatically at every stop on the route.

All buses depart from Riseholme College's Showground campus for return journeys at 17:15, and 16:45 on Fridays.

Students may use the 2, 15 and 16 Stagecoach bus routes for free to connect to the RC4A bus, which departs from St. Swithins Square at 08:33 daily. The same services can be used for their return journey on production of their student ID card (this is their bus pass).



Parking at Riseholme College

Students can park free of charge at any time at the college. However, you will need to apply for a parking permit. You can apply in advance by completing the application on our website. You'll find it at
